

Nationwide 341 Schools Peace Clubs created so far with Total of around **48811 Students and Teachers** as members

301 Existing Unity & Reconciliation Groups created and Empowered
Total Average of 10,000 Members(made of Genocide Survivors + Former Returned Convicted Ex-Genocide Prisoners + Respective belonging relatives)

2 new created functioning **Peace & Reconciliation Research Center** currently in Growing in 2 CDJP(Kigali & Byumba)

Around 1100 Psychosocial Animators for all 10 CDJPs
So far 1208 Communities Paralegal moving in all 10 CDJPs
A Total of 1780 Communities Peace Mediators nationwide
Around 2000 GBV Matrimonial Counsellors active in the 10 CDJPs
